Autumn Term 2017

English

- Write stories set in places pupils have been.
- Write stories with imaginary settings.
- Write stories and plays that use the language of fairy tales and traditional tales.
- Write lists and captions.
- Write instructions and recounts.
- Present information.
- Write poems that use pattern, rhyme and description.
- Listen to traditional tales and a range of texts.
- Learn some poems by heart.
- Discuss books.
- Use the class and school libraries.
- Listen to short novels over time.



Maths

- Count and calculate in a range of practical contexts.
- Use and apply mathematics in everyday activities and across the curriculum.
- Explore numbers and place value up to at least 100.
- Add and subtract using mental and formal written methods in practical contexts.
- Use language to describe position and movement.
- Use and apply in practical contexts a measures, including time.
- Handle data in practical contexts.

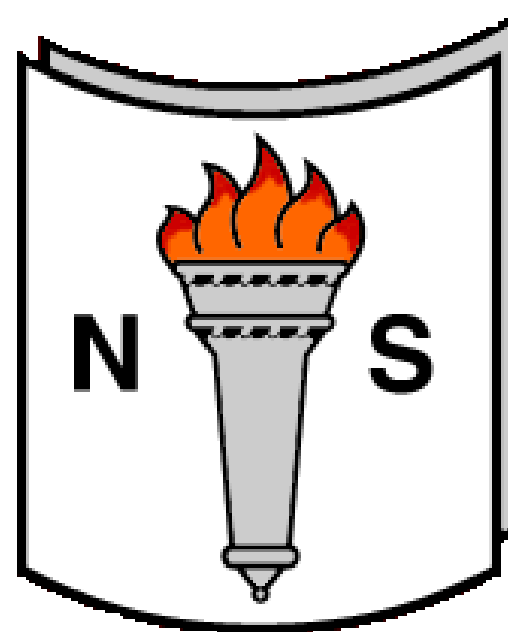
