

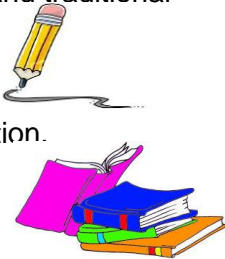
Curriculum Leaflet – Year 1

Summer Term 2019

Year 1 will be following the 2014 National Curriculum alongside Hertfordshire's own scheme for RE and Computing.

English

- Write stories that use the language of fairy tales and traditional tales.
- Write reports and explanations.
- Orally present information.
- Write poems that use pattern, rhyme and description.
- Listen to traditional tales and a range of texts.
- Learn to read and spell 100 HFW.
- Read books and learn to look for facts in the text.
- Use the class and school libraries.
- Write sentences using a capital letter and full stop, a question mark or exclamation mark.
- Join clauses using 'and' or 'because'.



Maths

- Count and calculate in a range of practical contexts.
- Use and apply mathematics in everyday activities and across the curriculum.
- Explore numbers and place value up to at least 100.
- Add and subtract using mental and formal written methods in practical contexts.
- Use multiplication and division facts and show answers using a range of practical equipment.
- Use language to describe position, direction and movement.
- Use and apply in practical contexts a range of measures, including time.
- Handle data in practical contexts.



Science

The children will be finding out about – '**Plants and Changes in Seasons**' This will also be covered within some of their topic in English and Maths lessons.

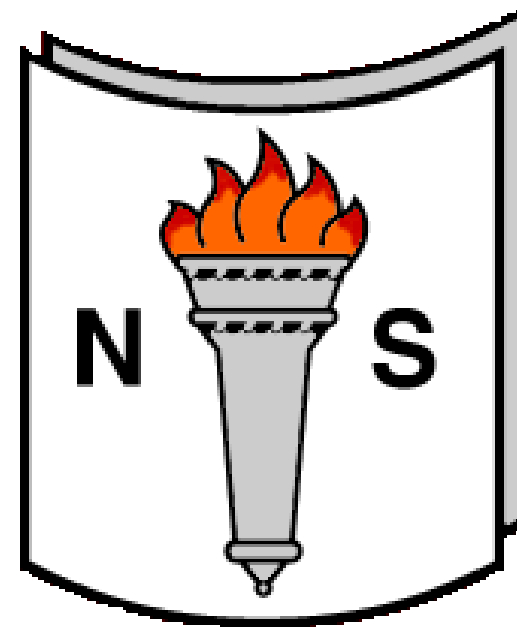
