Spring Term 2018

Year 1 will be following the 2014 National Curriculum alongside Hertfordshire's own schemes for RE and Computing.

English

- Write stories relating to the children's experiences,
- Write stories with imaginary settings.
- Report Writing
- Write instructions
- Present information
- Vocabulary building poems..
- Rhyming couplets.
- Learn some poems by heart.
- Use the class and school libraries.
- Learn to write a sentence with the correct punctuation
- Spell words from phase 5 Letters and Sounds



Maths

- Count and calculate in a range of practical contexts.
- Use and apply mathematics in everyday activities
- Explore numbers and place value up to at least 100.
- Count on and back in tens from any number; begin to count in 5s and 2s recognising multiples of 5
- Find half, quarter and three quarters of shapes
- Add and subtract using mental and formal written methods in practical contexts.
- Use language to describe position, direction and movement.
- Use and apply in practical contexts a range of measures, including time.
- Handle data in practical contexts.
- Name, recognise and know the properties of 3D shapes
- Relate units of time: weeks, days and hours



Science

The children will be finding out about – '**Seasons**' and '**Animals including Humans**'. This may also be covered within some of their topic or Maths lessons.

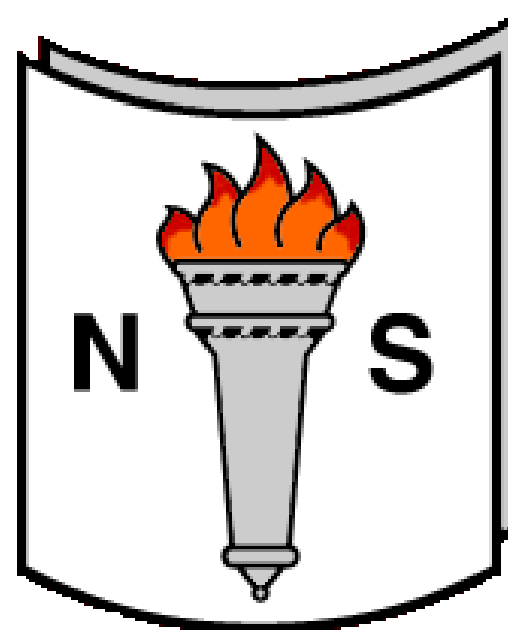
